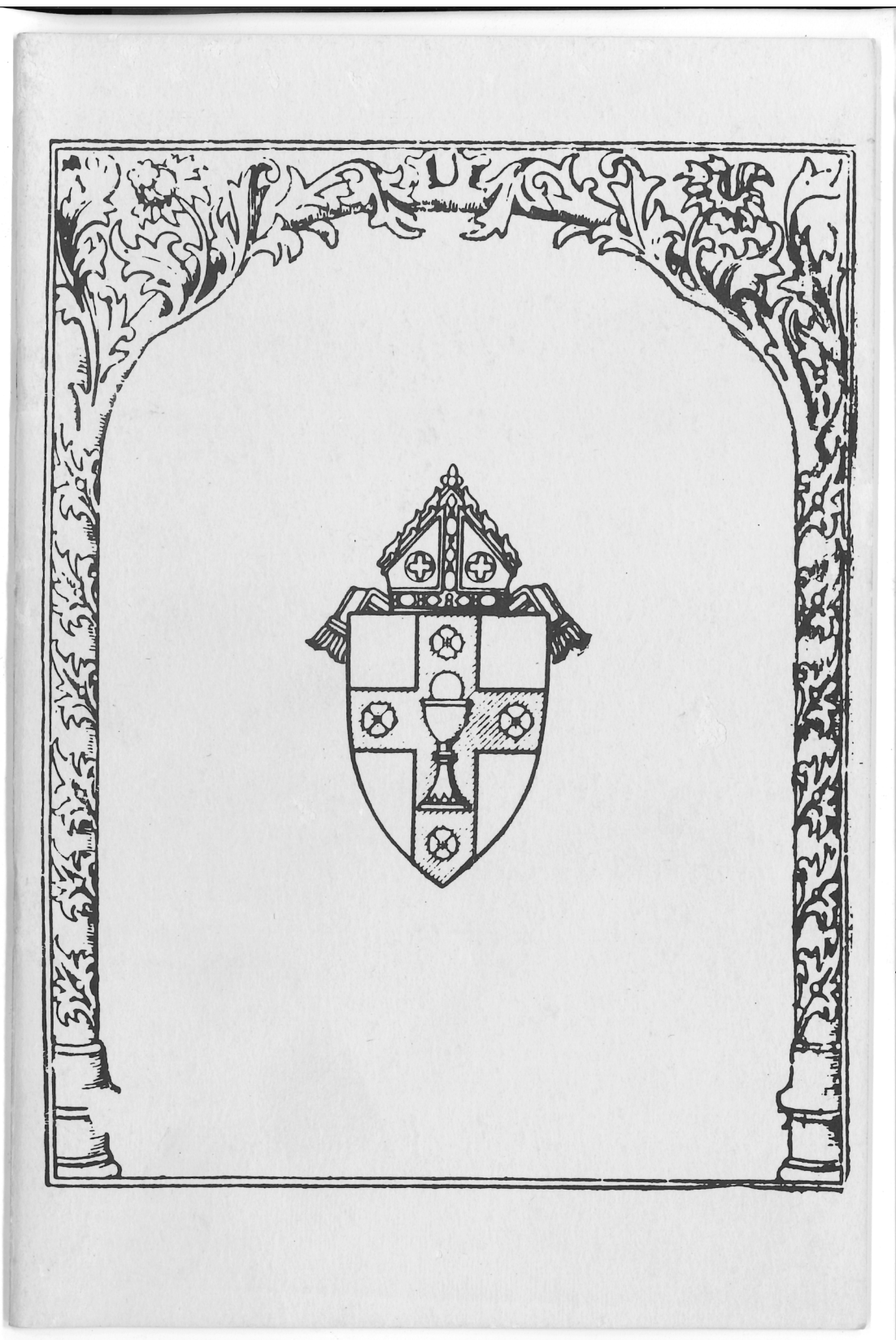




THE ORDINARY OF THE MASS
